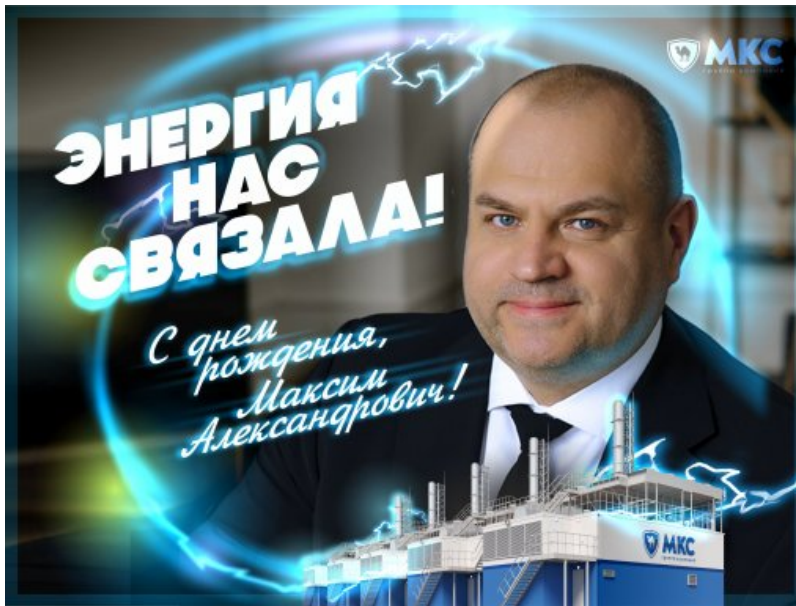


"Energy has connected us". ISS staff shot a clip for Maxim Zagornov's birthday
